*Teacher access to streaming educational videos and lesson plans is coming to Ohio educators beginning in February 2007 at the Ohio Digital Classroom's new website. Here anyone can directly access free educational videos and lesson plans through its Teachers' Domain portal.*

Ohio (February 2007)—The ODC is a statewide source for rich media content correlated to Ohio standards. Its purpose is to promote the educational use of digital content and delivery in Ohio schools.
